



### STATE OF EDUCATION IN SDO MALOLOS







For SY 2017-2018, there has been an increase in enrollment for the Kindergarten level in both the public and private schools. This is attributed to the clarification on age appropriateness of Kinder learners as embodied in DepEd Order no. 47 s. 2016. In the private schools, the increase in enrollees was a result of the establishment of new preschools as well as the issuance of DepEd permits to preschools which have been operating for some time without permits.

The junior high school enrolment in Malolos did not show much of an increase considering the proximity of Malolos in nearby towns of Apalit, Pampanga, Plaridel, Guiguinto, Balagtas, Paombong and Bulakan. The increased enrolment in private senior high school in its pilot year is attributed to the Voucher program of DepEd allowing public grade 10 completers to enroll in no top up Senior High School implementers.





STATUS OF DEPED-BASIC EDUCATION FACILITIES FUND (BEFF)






